



Thou Blanc

Over the years, the Piedmont region has become an established producer of white grapes as well as red, resulting in fresh and surprisingly intense wines. Even Chardonnay, an internationally planted variety, has established a niche in Piedmont, with excellent results.

Thou Blanc grapes (named for the White Tufa that forms the backbone of the soil in the hills of the region) are cultivated in two vineyards, one in the Langa and the other in Monferrato. Both are on the calcareous/tufaceous soils of fresh north-facing slopes, at an altitude of 350m above sea level. With its mineral quality reflected in the persistence of the aftertaste, the wine departs from the standard taste spectrum of international Chardonnays, affirming its individuality.

Only fine Chardonnay from Burgundy. Two vineyards, in Langa and Monferrato.	Fermentation in steel vats, where the wine is left to rest on its yeasts for six months. This pure Chardonnay never comes in contact with wood during its production.	Delicate, luminous yellow colour, smooth with a fresh, fragrant, moderately fruity bouquet and varietal notes. Its full texture makes it suitable for universal use.
